
We read the story of *The Good Stranger* through Godly play and thought about how we could be a good neighbour to others. We acted out the story in our tuff tray and drew beautiful pictures

Handwriting

We are sending home handwriting homework – this can be completed over the Easter break. Please check that your child is holding the pencil effectively for writing, using a tripod grip (I have attached a stages in pencil control sheet for reference)

It is crucial that the children learn to write each

letter of the alphabet with the correct formation – by this we mean, starting in the right place and following the correct direction. This skill will feed into the development of a cursive script in Key Stage 1. We have sent home an alphabet formation mat for reference. Please supervise your child during this activity to avoid the children forming the letter inaccurately.

We would like the children to practise writing their names (booklet provided) with a capital letter at the <u>start</u> only, making sure every single letter is formed accurately in accordance with the sheet. If your child is confident with this, please encourage them to write other words too.


